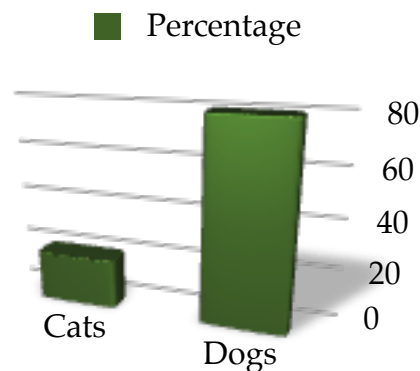

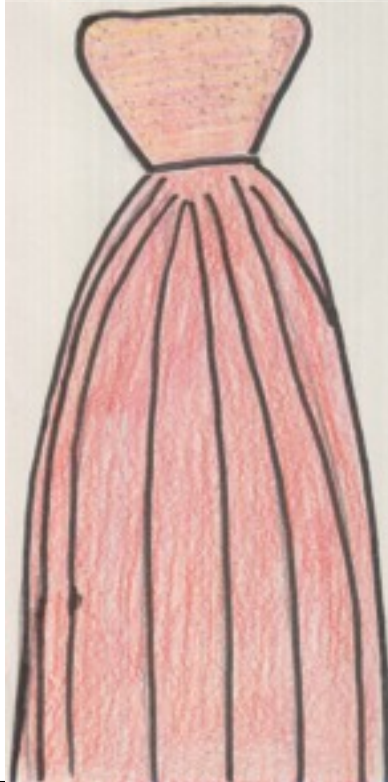
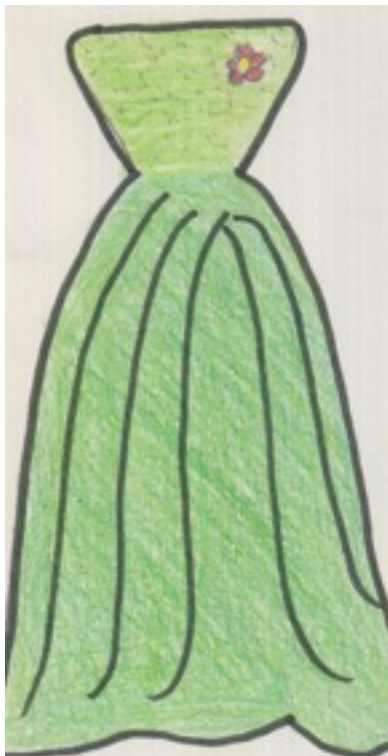
## Survey: Dogs vs. Cats
