For those attending morning sessions (3rd - 6th grade), classes will begin at this start time, 10:30am, on designated Camp Husky days. This schedule will allow students time to return home for remote instruction.

Important Message on Camp Husky's Registration Process.

Dear Families,

Camp Husky is now in session; view the schedules below. We have been enjoying having children on campus these last few days. If you have not enrolled but wish to join Camp Husky, **you must register in advance by emailing camphusky@sjsla.org and completing all testing and authorization forms** (see below for more detail). When registering, please list your child's grade level and teacher's name in the subject line: ex. 2nd Grade, Wilbur Smith. This program allows Kindergarten to have two 90-minute outdoor activity blocks and all other grade levels to have one 90-minute outdoor activity block.

To be completed before attending Camp Husky:

Please remember that your child should be tested for COVID-19 per Nurse Cardoza's letter on [Friday, October 30th](#). To provide your student's test results, please visit your [Magnus account](#) and click on the "Turn it in" button for COVID-19 Test Results and Authorization. Please print the Authorization For Disclosure And Use Of Medical Information form. Once complete, upload both the Authorization For Disclosure form and your child's test results. After you have uploaded a copy, please bring the original authorization form to campus for your child's first day on campus.

We have established a daily health screening protocol for students coming to the campus. In compliance with government health orders, each day your student is planning to come to campus, you will need to complete a brief COVID-19 screening assessment before arriving at school. The assessment should be completed by 7:30am for students participating in morning sessions and by 12:30pm for students participating in afternoon sessions. Please follow the [instructions](#) to download the Magnus Mobile app. Once you [complete the screening for the day](#), the app will indicate whether you may proceed to campus. Please be prepared to display the screening outcome on your smartphone when you arrive on campus. Contact Alicia Cardoza, our school nurse, for any questions on the Magnus app or attendance. Both parents must also electronically sign an "Acknowledgment of Risks and Informed Consent for In-Person Activities and/or Learning Program". You should have received a separate email from Emmy Gilliam via Adobe Sign, from SJS Tech, with a personalized version of this form for you to electronically sign.

All children must be present by 8:00am for grades 3-6 Camp Husky and by 1:00pm for grades K-2. All children must be picked up promptly by 9:45am for grades 3-6 and by 2:45pm for grades K-2. Families may not enter campus; please be sure you have taken your child's temperature at home and completed the Magnus daily check before coming to campus.

Children should not bring anything beyond their own filled water bottle for the day; no backpacks, snacks, book bags, etc. are allowed. Children should be changed and ready for Camp Husky when they arrive. All children must also have a clean mask each day. Please note that Camp Husky will take the place of

our PE program until at least the end of January. If your child is not participating in the camp, please note that Ms. Geoffrey and Mr. DiPasquale will not be providing curriculum and feedback on PE outside of the camp.

All other days the schedule follows the regular remote schedule with classes 9:30 to 12:00, an hour for lunch, and resume 1:00 to 2:30. Co-Curricular classes will continue to be offered, except for PE, during the 2:30 to 3:30 block for 3rd through 6th grades.
