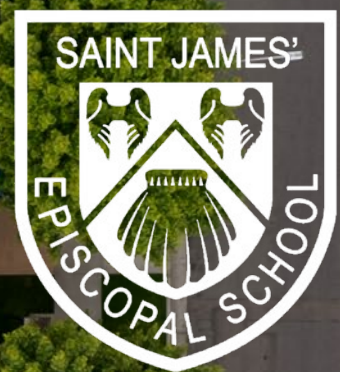

MISSION STATEMENT

St. James' Episcopal School is a diverse, joyful, and inclusive community of learners. With a focus on academic excellence and attention to the needs of each child, we strive to instill in our students intellectual curiosity, compassion for others, and respect for all of God's creation.

PHILOSOPHY

Paramount to our philosophy of teaching and learning is the belief that intelligence is neither a fixed nor an unchanging commodity. St. James' intentionally expands each child's capacity for learning in a thoughtfully designed environment where children are not just "taught;" they are encouraged to explore, investigate, work collaboratively, and as John Dewey exhorted over a century ago, treat the classroom as a laboratory where the child is on a joyous and constant journey for knowledge and understanding.

We believe that children should have the opportunity to construct meaning as they assimilate knowledge. Rather than merely providing rote learning in our classrooms, we encourage our teachers to stretch the children's ability to analyze, synthesize, and evaluate what they learn; to apply their learning to new situations; and to apply what they learn to serving and leading in a complicated but beautiful world. As a 1:1 technological device institution, technology is essential to our work with children as they leverage technology responsibly, creatively and with facility on their lifelong path of learning. A rich socio-emotional curriculum through the visual and performing arts, athletics, student clubs and activities provides children with generous time for what Dewey referred to as collateral instruction, and the assurance that every child is seen, heard and expresses their feelings daily. We know that such a practice ensures intellectually and socio-emotionally successful students.

St. James' primary purpose is to provide our students with the thinking strategies they will need to apply in order to serve and lead in the world. Through a rigorous academic and affective program, grounded in the practice of empathy and imbued with regular service for those who are hungry or unhoused in Los Angeles, we graduate servant leaders who will go on to have an enormously powerful and balming influence on the world as caring global citizens. Our students and graduates hold a profound appreciation for the differences that mark each human being as an individual of inestimable worth and dignity.

Most importantly, I want to acknowledge the tireless work of our board of trustees, and Rich Chisholm, our board chair. The board has been integral and essential in the school navigating this pandemic while continuing to steward policies that have allowed us to pay our employees generously and fairly. Thanks to our board's careful work, we have historic liquidity and a stellar investment portfolio. I am very grateful to them for their support, vision and leadership.

I am very excited about St. James' present - and enthusiastic and confident about this tremendous school's future. My thanks again for all that you have done to support our community.

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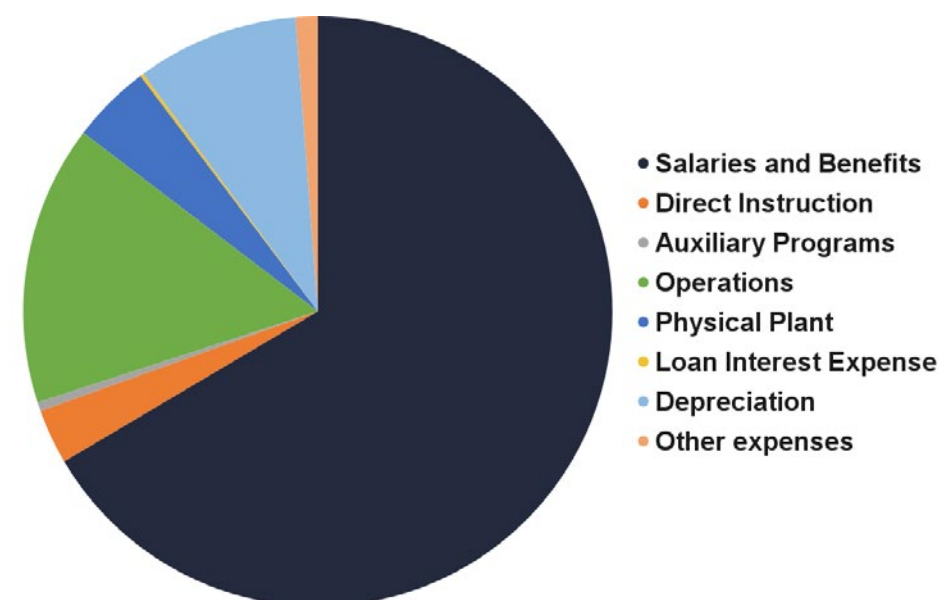

LETTER FROM RICH CHISHOLM PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES



The true test of a community is not how it functions in the good times but how it performs in the challenging times. And I could not be more proud of how the St. James' community has not just weathered the pandemic but has thrived in the midst of it.

These are challenging times. I remember working with Peter Reinke at the outset of this Covid pandemic when we decided to close the school for two weeks before Spring Break 2020. We fully expected to re-open St. James' after the four weeks had elapsed. And, we were only a year off (along with most other people that responded to the pandemic)!

Yet there is so much to be proud of during these times including some of these highlights:

- The incredible efforts of the staff in putting together the St. James' at Home program in a matter of weeks that allowed our children to continue their robust education while also feeling emotionally supported.
- The efforts of the entire community led by Peter Reinke to be one of the first private elementary schools in Los Angeles to resume full time in-person learning back in March of 2021.
- How, fortunately, we had already raised funds for a 1:1 program which allowed us to fulfill every student request for an iPad or Chromebook during the St. James' at Home program.
- The nimbleness and compassion of the community to create financial aid programs to ensure that no family would have to leave St. James' for the 2020-2021 school year because of the financial difficulties raised by the pandemic.
- The fact that we set new fundraising records for the Every Child Fund because of the incredible generosity shown by our community.

Perhaps most importantly, however, was the love and patience we showed each other during this period despite the stresses of having our children at home and having widely divergent views on the best path forward.

I firmly believe that the "secret sauce" of St. James' is not the excellent education (which, of course, is essential) or even the amazing staff that we are blessed to have but it is our community. It is you and your children.

Thank you for making St. James' the special place we all know it is.

Annual Giving is our philanthropic priority at St. James' and during this extraordinarily challenging year, the St. James' community demonstrated that our school is a philanthropic priority in their lives. With many families experiencing sudden hardships due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the goal for the annual fund was reduced. By the end of the school year however, the annual fund had raised \$958,126 – a comparable amount to previous years. This show of support for St. James' during this difficult year is a testament to our community and the uniquely supportive environment our students enjoy.

The annual fund, referred to as The Every Child Fund, provides investment in our school that in turn delivers enhancements right across the board; from curriculum to campus to staff professional development to family tuition assistance – a wide array of resources that will set up every child for success.

As the cornerstone of our philanthropy at St. James', The Every Child Fund directly impacts all students by supporting:

- Differentiation in the classroom. The Every Child Fund supports our multi-year plan to have two lead teachers in each classroom for all core curriculum.
- An expanded Performing Arts Department to include dance and drama as well as instrumental music.
- An expanded Servant Leadership Program including a dedicated food pantry run by the 6th grade.
- The Teaching & Learning Institute to foster growth minded, enthusiastic and empathetic instruction.
- Beyond School, our tuition-inclusive after care program.
- Professional Development to ensure teachers identify and support the socio-emotional needs of our students.
- Accessible and affordable tuition per the parish and school mission to be accessible to Los Angeles families.
- Generous tuition-assistance to ensure a socio-economically diverse student body.

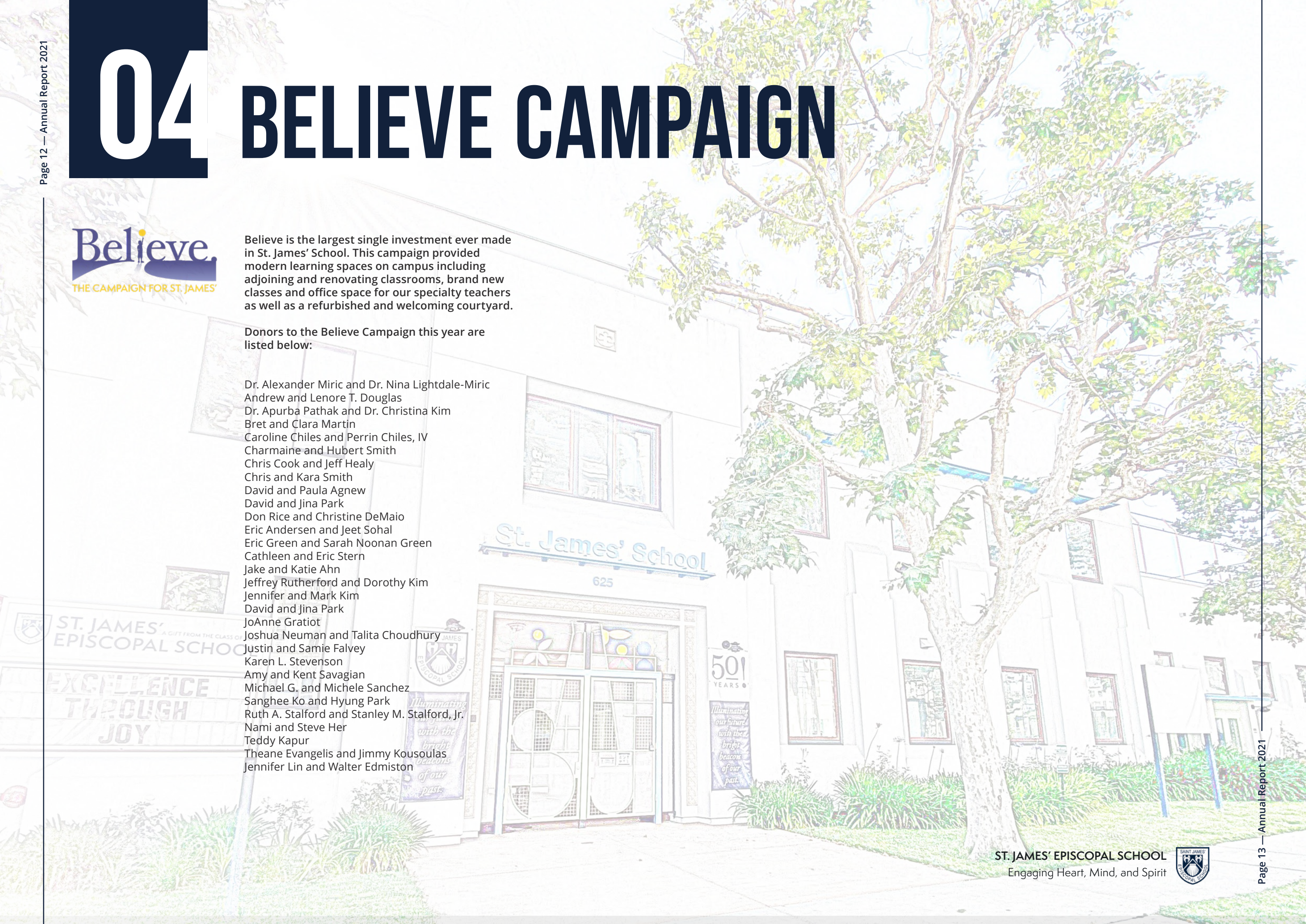
BELIEVE CAMPAIGN
