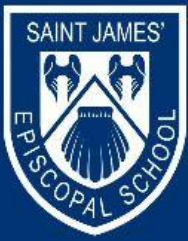

Theo said, "Banana with ketchup and pancakes!"

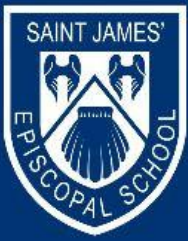

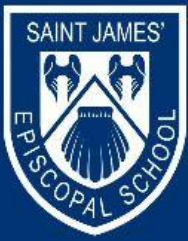

Artisan necklace

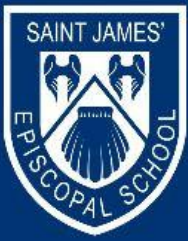
Materials: Beads and string

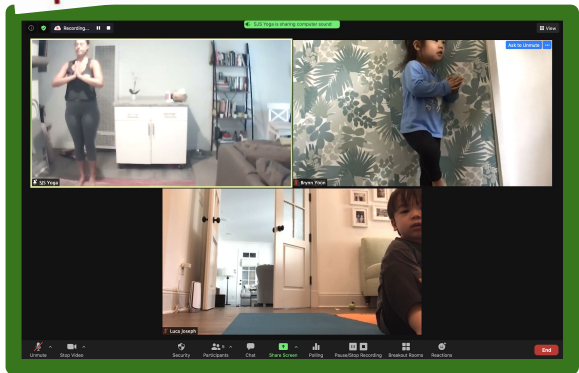

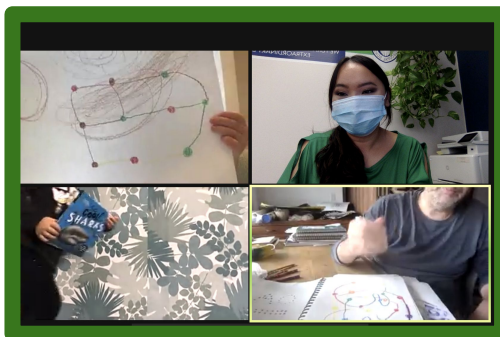
